The town, originally known as Brandal City and Kings Bay, was founded that summer when coal mining commenced. construction of a school, and new mines were opened. In the mid-1920s the town was used for a series of airship expeditions towards the North Pole. Not until the 1860s were they investigated more carefully. Ålesund-based Peter Brandal bought the claims in 1916 and established the company Kings Bay. The first research installation, a geophysical station at Kvadehuken, was established in 1920 4c3646dea4
