Logan v. Zimmerman Brush Co. 422, is a unanimous 1982 decision of the U. S. The decision reversed the Illinois Supreme Court's holding to the contrary two years prior. Supreme Court concerning the Due Process Clause of the Fourteenth Amendment. The Court held that the petitioner was entitled to have his discrimination complaint adjudged by Illinois's Fair Employment Practices Commission (FEPC), which had dismissed it for its own failure to meet a deadline. Zimmerman Brush Co. , 455 U. Justice Harry Logan v. granted Logan certiorari to argue on appeal that his constitutional rights to equal protection and due process of law had been violated. The Bill of Rights was proposed to assuage Anti-Federalist opposition to Constitutional ratification The First Amendment (Amendment I) to the United States Constitution prevents Congress from making laws respecting an establishment of religion; prohibiting the free exercise of religion; or abridging the freedom of speech, the freedom of the press, the freedom of assembly, or the right to petition the government for redress of grievances. The first two articles were not ratified by the states, so the article on disestablishment and free speech ended up being first. article on disestablishment and free speech ended up being first. It was adopted on December 15, 1791, as one of the ten amendments that constitute the Bill of Rights cb501a3cb1
