It is the type species of *Cephalophus*, and placed in the subfamily Cephalophinae and family Bovidae. The species was first described by Swedish botanist Adam Afzelius in the journal *Nova Acta Regiæ Societatis Scientiarum Upsaliensis* in 1815. The generic name has possibly originated from the combination of the New Latin word *cephal*, meaning head, and the Greek word *lophos*, meaning crest. The specific name *silvicultor* is composed by two Latin words: *silva*, meaning wood,

and cultus, which relates to cultivation. This refers to its habitat. eb43323061 The San Joaquin antelope squirrel is found in the San Joaquin Valley, including slopes and ridge tops along the western edge of the valley. It is endemic to the region, and is found in a much smaller range today than it originally inhabited. Mechanical ventilation is used for many reasons, including to protect the airway due to mechanical or neurologic cause, to ensure adequate oxygenation, or to remove excess carbon dioxide from the lungs. Patients should be considered for weaning as soon as they are able to support their own ventilation and oxygenation, and this Mechanical ventilation or assisted ventilation is the medical term for using a ventilator machine to fully or partially provide artificial ventilation eb43323061

The squirrels live in small underground familial colonies on sandy, easily excavated grasslands in isolated locations in San Luis Obispo and Kern Counties. Common vegetation associated with the squirrel includes Atriplex and Ephedra, and some junipers. The binomial of this species commemorates the American naturalist Edward William Nelson.
