Plutonium It is radioactive and can accumulate in bones, which makes the handling of plutonium dangerous. When exposed to moist air, it forms oxides and hydrides that can expand the sample up to 70% in volume, which in turn flake off as a powder that is pyrophoric. The element normally exhibits six allotropes and four oxidation states. It reacts with carbon, halogens, nitrogen, silicon, and hydrogen. It is a silvery-gray actinide metal that tarnishes when exposed to air, and forms a dull coating when oxidized.
