Various events or incidents that compromise IT in some way can therefore cause adverse impacts on the organization's business processes or mission, ranging from inconsequential to catastrophic in scale. While information has long been appreciated as a valuable and important asset, the rise of the knowledge economy and the Digital Revolution has led to organizations becoming increasingly dependent on information, information processing and especially IT. Penetration test Several standard frameworks and methodologies A penetration test, colloquially known as a pentest, is an authorized simulated cyberattack on a computer system, performed to evaluate the security of the system; this is not to be confused with a vulnerability assessment. Penetration testing also can support risk assessments as outlined in the NIST Risk Management Framework SP 800-53. The test is performed to identify weaknesses (or vulnerabilities), including the potential for unauthorized

parties to gain access to the system's features and data, as well as strengths, enabling a full risk assessment to be completed 2bdca2d5c6

The process typically identifies the target systems and a particular goal, then reviews available information and undertakes various means to attain that goal. If remediation is done by removal the waste materials are simply transported off-site for disposal at another location.
