Prime number For example, 5 is prime because the only ways of writing it as a product, 1×5 or 5×1 , involve 5 itself. However, 4 is composite because it is a product (2×2) in which both numbers are smaller than 4. Primes are central in number theory because of the fundamental theorem of arithmetic: every natural number greater than 1 is either a prime itself or can be factorized as a product of primes that is unique up to their order. Modular sums, differences and products are calculated by performing the same replacement by the remainder on the result of the usual sum, difference, or product A prime number (or a prime) is a natural number greater than 1 that is not a product of two smaller natural numbers. A natural number greater than 1 that is not prime is called a composite number

Tajima's D differences between pairs sampled (these are called pairwise differences). Tajima's D is computed as the difference between two measures of genetic diversity: the mean number of pairwise differences and the number of segregating sites, each scaled so that they are expected to be the same in a neutrally evolving population of constant size. To standardize the pairwise differences, the mean or 'average' number of pairwise Tajima's D is a population genetic test statistic created by and named after the Japanese researcher Fumio Tajima

It also partially corrects the bias in the estimation of the population standard deviation. This technique is named after Friedrich Bessel.
