The levels of individuals on nonobservable latent variables are inferred through mathematical modeling based on what is observed from individuals' responses to items on tests and scales. Examples of latent constructs include intelligence, introversion, mental disorders, and educational achievement. Psychometrics generally covers specialized fields within psychology and education devoted to testing, measurement, assessment, and related activities. they can give only wrong answers or no answers at all regarding certain important problems.
