This cycle was the first metabolic cycle to be discovered by Hans Krebs and Kurt Henseleit in 1932, five years before the discovery of the TCA cycle. The splay in the glucose titration curve is likely a result of both anatomical and kinetic difference among nephrons. A particular nephron's filtered load of glucose may be mismatched to its capacity to reabsorb glucose.
