Potassium burnt wood or tree leaves, adding water, heating, and evaporating the solution. Elemental potassium reacts vigorously with water, generating sufficient heat to ignite hydrogen emitted in the reaction, and burning. It is a silvery white metal that is soft enough to easily cut with a knife. When Humphry Davy first isolated the pure element using electrolysis in Potassium is a chemical element; it has symbol K (from Neo-Latin kalium) and atomic number 19. In the periodic table, potassium is one of the alkali metals, all of which have a single valence electron in the outer electron shell, which is easily removed to create an ion with a positive charge (which combines with anions to form salts). Potassium metal reacts rapidly with atmospheric oxygen to form flaky white potassium peroxide in only seconds of exposure. In nature, potassium occurs only in ionic salts. It was first isolated from potash, the ashes of plants, from which its name derives 1a0ecbe6d6

Calorie SI unit of energy at the ninth General Conference on Weights and Measures in 1948. The large calorie, food calorie, dietary calorie, or kilogram calorie is defined as the amount of heat needed to raise the temperature of one liter of water by one degree Celsius (or one kelvin). The small calorie or gram calorie is defined as the amount of heat needed to cause the same increase in one milliliter of water.
