Café Pamplona Cambridge luminaries. When it opened in 1959 it was the first café in the Square. The owner, Josefina Yanguas, claimed the café had the first espresso-maker in the city. 2005 Red Lake shootings The dead included an unarmed security guard at the entrance of the school, a teacher, and five students. Weise shot and killed seven people at the school and wounded nine others. counseling and a prescription for Prozac, an anti-depressant.
