It is a dynamic programming language providing a framework for acoustic research, algorithmic music, interactive programming, and live coding. Scratch is developed by the MIT Media Lab and has been translated into 70+ languages, being used in most parts of the world. Scratch is taught and used in after-school centers, schools, and colleges, as well as other public knowledge institutions. As of 15 February 2023, community statistics on the language's official website show more than 123 million projects shared by over 103 million users, and more than 95 million monthly website visits. Overall, more than 1.3 billion projects have been created in total, with the site reaching its one millionth project in April 21st, 2010 and its one billionth project on April 12th, 2024. The format gained worldwide acceptance in 1983–84, selling more than a million CD players in its first two years, to play 22.5 million discs, before overtaking records and cassette tapes to become the dominant standard for commercial music. Peaking around year 2000, the audio CD contracted over the next decade due to rising popularity and revenue from digital downloading, and during the 2010s by digital music streaming, but has remained as one of the primary distribution methods for the music industry. In the United States, phonograph record revenues surpassed the CD in 2020 for the first time since the 1980s... At low speeds of playback, the result is a kind of soundscape, often described as a cloud, that is manipulated in a manner unlike that of natural sound sampling or other synthesis techniques.
