Eduroam shared the idea of combining a RADIUS-based infrastructure with IEEE 802. Authorization to access the Internet and other resources are handled by the visited institution. It provides researchers, teachers, and students network access when visiting an institution other than their own. Users are authenticated with credentials from their home institution, regardless of the location of the eduroam access point.
