Legalization of non-medical cannabis in the United States S. The Cole memo remained in effect until January 2018 when it was In the United States, the non-medical use of cannabis is legalized in 24 states (plus Guam, the Northern Mariana Islands, the U. Virgin Islands, and the District of Columbia) and decriminalized in 7 states, as of November 2023. McClintock-Polis amendment was narrowly defeated on June 3, 2015, by a vote of 206 to 222. In jurisdictions without penalty the policy is referred to as legalization, although the term decriminalization is sometimes used for this purpose as well. Decriminalization refers to a policy of reduced penalties for cannabis offenses, typically involving a civil penalty for possessing small amounts (similar to how a minor traffic violation is treated), instead of criminal prosecution or the threat of arrest 26
