Unwarranted variation Studies have Unwarranted variation (or geographic variation) in health care service delivery refers to medical practice pattern variation that cannot be explained by illness, medical need, or the dictates of evidence-based medicine. It is one of the causes of low value care often ignored by health systems. if unwarranted variation in the US healthcare system could be reduced, the quality of care would go up and healthcare costs would go down
