Brera was also a member of the Association Internationale des Économistes de Langue Française (International Association... In the Sicilian Mafia, the position does not exist. For instance, the old-style Mafia boss Calogero Vizzini was often portrayed in the media as the "boss of bosses" – although such a position does not exist according to later Mafia pentiti, such as Tommaso Buscetta. They also denied Vizzini ever was the ruling boss of the Mafia in Sicily. According to Mafia historian Salvatore Lupo "the emphasis of the media on the definition of 'capo dei capi' is without any foundation". Corsi worked for the newspapers Il Tempo and Il Mattino and was a correspondent for Il Giorno, La Repubblica, Roma, Il Mondo and L'Europeo, amongst others. Messina Denaro became a fugitive on the most wanted list of the Italian Ministry of the Interior in 1993; according to Forbes in 2010, he was one of the ten most wanted and powerful criminals in the world. With the deaths of Bernardo Provenzano in 2016 and Salvatore Riina in 2017, Messina Denaro was seen as the unchallenged boss of all bosses within the Mafia. After 30 years on the run, he was arrested on 16 January 2023 near a private clinic in Sicily's capital, Palermo, where he was reportedly undergoing chemotherapy under a false name. Messina Denaro died in a prison hospital on 25 September 2023... H2biz was founded in November 2008 as a social business network. In 1994, he won the Amantea prize for historiography and was rewarded with merit by the then President Carlo Azeglio Ciampi. == Sicilian Mafia == Plot == Recchione was born in Sant'Angelo dei Lombardi near Chieti, Province of Chieti. He moved with his parents to Palena. After elementary studies in Palena, he moved to further studies in Pescocostanzo in the Abruzzi. In 1856, his uncle, a doctor and professor at the University in Naples, brought Recchione to study, where he enrolled in the Academy of Fine Arts of Naples, along with his friend Teofilo Patini, studying under Basilio Puoti, Biagio Molinari, and Giuseppe Mancinelli. By 1859, he was gravitating to the circle of the painters del vero, Domenico Morelli and Filippo Palizzi. After the fall of the Bourbon monarchy, Recchione helped found the Society for the Promotion of the Arts in Naples. Later in life, he moved to Palena in the Abruzzo. He died in Naples, aged 63. == Life and career ==

He started his film career as assistant operator of Vittorio Storaro in Daniele D'Anza's Pagni, pupe e marinai. He is best known for his association with Carmelo Bene, with whom he collaborated as a cinematographer in all his films, including the Venice Film Festival Special Jury Prize winner Our Lady of the Turks; other notable collaborations include Paolo and Vittorio Taviani (notably being the cinematographer of Palme d'Or winner Padre Padrone), Bruno Bozzetto, Giuseppe Ferrara and Vittorio De Sisti. In the 1980s Masini retired from the industry to work as a teacher in some Steiner schools, and later moved to Stuttgart. He reprised his cinema activities in the early 1990s, working mainly in independent and arthouse international productions. Brera earned his degree in Political Economy from Milan's Bocconi University, where later on he was Assistant Professor of Economic History (1974–78). In 1977 he spent a few months at the Poznań University of Economics in Poland as a visiting scholar. From 1978–81 he worked at the Italian subsidiary of the French oil company Total, pursuing his research programme as a side occupation. Until 1985 he was a member of the Italian Socialist Party's (PSI) Economic Commission. In 2011 born FashionBiz, the brand dedicated to fashion. After graduating from classical high school, he earned a degree in modern literature from the University of Naples Federico II. Matteo Messina Denaro The son of a Mafia boss, Denaro became known nationally on 12 April 2001 when the magazine L'Espresso put him on the cover with the headline: Ecco il nuovo capo della Mafia ("Here is the new Mafia boss"). He was considered to be one of the new leaders of the Cosa Nostra after the arrests of Bernardo Provenzano on 11 April 2006 and Salvatore Lo Piccolo in November 2007.
