Lean manufacturing It is closely related to another concept called just-in-time manufacturing (JIT manufacturing in short). specific and quantitative terms, via published case studies; second, general listings and discussion. Just-in-time manufacturing tries to match production to demand by only supplying goods that have been ordered and focus on efficiency, productivity (with a commitment to continuous improvement), and reduction of "wastes" for the producer and supplier of goods. Lean manufacturing adopts the just-in-time approach and additionally focuses on reducing cycle, flow, and throughput times by further eliminating activities that do not add any value for the customer. Lean manufacturing also involves people who work outside of. Chaos theory These were once thought to have completely random states of disorder and irregularities. It focuses on underlying patterns and deterministic laws of dynamical systems that are highly sensitive to initial conditions. The butterfly effect, an underlying principle of chaos, describes how a small change in one state of a deterministic nonlinear system can result in large differences in a later state (meaning there is sensitive dependence on initial conditions). Chaos theory states that within the apparent randomness of chaotic complex systems, there are underlying patterns, interconnection, constant feedback loops, repetition, self-similarity, fractals and self-organization. reason is, simply put, that solutions to such systems are asymptotic to a two-dimensional surface and therefore solutions are well behaved. While the Chaos theory is an interdisciplinary area of scientific study and branch of mathematics. A metaphor for this behavior is
