This results in approximately two-thirds of the population scoring between IQ 85 and IQ 115 and about 2 percent each above 130 and below 70. Originally, IQ was a score obtained by dividing a person's estimated mental age, obtained by administering an intelligence test, by the person's chronological age. abilities give different answers to specific

questions on the same IQ test. For modern IQ tests, the raw score is transformed to a normal distribution with mean 100 and standard deviation 15

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
