Lend-Lease Sherman tanks Under the terms of the Lend-Lease, the United States supplied over 17,000 Shermans to Allied nations, making it one of the most heavily exported tanks of the conflict. was continued, giving it the name Sherman after Union General William Tecumseh Sherman. The largest recipients were the United Kingdom and the Soviet Union, both of which integrated the Sherman into their armored forces alongside domestically produced vehicles. The US later adopted the name and the practice of naming tanks The Medium Tank M4, commonly known as the Sherman, was the most widely used American tank of World War II

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Rupp Industries Rupp vehicles are known for their performance and bright red coloring, particularly the snowmobiles and off-road vehicles. minibikes were made with disc brakes as well as the introduction of Tecumseh engines, which Rupp would use until the discontinuation of their minibikes Rupp Industries was a Mansfield, Ohio-based manufacturer of go-karts, minibikes, snowmobiles and other off-road vehicles founded by Mickey Rupp in 1959. It was developed during the war, and the first test flight was made on 26 May 1942. The M4 Sherman proved to be reliable, relatively cheap to produce, and available in great numbers.
