A standardized test is administered and scored uniformly for all test takers. Any test in which the same test is given in the same manner to all test takers, and graded in the same manner for everyone, is a standardized test. Standardized tests do not need to be high-stakes tests, time-limited tests, multiple-choice tests, academic tests, or tests given to large numbers of test takers. Standardized tests can take various forms, including written, oral, or practical test. Restorative practices RP has been growing in popularity since the early 2000s and varying approaches exist. These various fields employ different terms, all of which fall under the rubric of restorative practices: In the criminal justice field the phrase used Restorative practices (or RP) is a social science field concerned with improving and repairing relationships and social connections among people. In fact, the purpose of RP is to build healthy communities, increase social capital, decrease crime and antisocial behavior, mend harm and restore

relationships. It ties together research in a variety of social science fields, including education, psychology, social work, criminology, sociology, organizational development and leadership. Whereas a zero tolerance social mediation system prioritizes punishment, RP privileges the repair of harm and dialogue among actors 8c169da9ea

Holistic grading grade on a paper's overall quality. It differs from other methods of scoring written discourse in two basic ways. It treats the composition as a whole, not assigning separate values to different parts of the writing. Holistic grading can also be used to assess classroom-based work. And it uses two or more raters, with the final score derived. Rather than counting errors, a paper is judged holistically and often compared to an anchor paper to evaluate if it meets a writing standard. This type of grading, which is also described as nonreductionist grading, contrasts with analytic grading, which takes Holistic grading or holistic scoring, in standards-based education, is an approach to scoring essays using a simple grading structure that bases a grade on a paper's overall quality. Writing assessment can also refer to the technologies and practices used to evaluate student writing and learning.
