His journey from Troy to Ithaca lasts an additional ten years, during which time he encounters many perils and all of his crewmates are killed. Like the Iliad, the Odyssey is divided into 24 books. Armstrong says both epics may have dropped from knowledge otherwise, citing Beowulf as an example of this fate. It follows the heroic king of Ithaca, Odysseus, also known by the Latin variant Ulysses, and his homecoming journey after the ten-year long Trojan War dd6a39b1ba

By 1066, most of the people of what is now England spoke Old English.
