However, if a stone grows to more than 5 millimeters (0. 2 inches), it can cause a blockage of the ureter, resulting in extremely sharp and severe pain (renal colic) in the lower back that often radiates downward to the groin. Because renal calculi typically form in the kidney, if small enough, they are able to leave the urinary tract via the urine stream. Radiation therapy may be curative in a number of types of cancer if they are localized to one area of the body, and have not spread to other parts. Radiation therapy is synergistic with chemotherapy, and has been used before, during, and after chemotherapy in susceptible cancers. It is normally delivered by a linear particle accelerator. It may also be used as part of adjuvant therapy, to prevent tumor recurrence after surgery to remove a primary malignant tumor (for example, early stages of breast cancer). Attacks are random and may occur secondary to a trigger (see Signs Pheochromocytoma (British English: phaeochromocytoma) is a rare tumor of the adrenal medulla composed of chromaffin cells and is a pharmacologically volatile, potentially lethal catecholamine-containing tumor of chromaffin tissue. Pheochromocytoma-related hypertensive emergencies are one of the most feared clinical manifestations. It is part of the paraganglioma (PGL). Some PGLs may secrete little to no catecholamines, or only secrete paroxysmally (episodically), and other than secretions, PGLs can still become clinically relevant through other secretions or mass effect (most common with head and neck PGL) acbcf18adc
