In Gestalt theory, information is perceived as wholes rather than disparate parts which are then processed summatively. This alteration in a person's thinking produces less anxiety and depression. This therapy focuses on challenging unhelpful and irrational negative thoughts and beliefs, referred to as 'self-talk' and replacing them with more rational positive self-talk.
