Vaccine hesitancy Therefore, the World Health Organization characterizes vaccine hesitancy as one of the top ten global health threats. The term covers refusals to vaccinate, delaying vaccines, accepting vaccines but remaining uncertain about their use, or using certain vaccines but not others. Vaccine hesitancy often results in disease outbreaks and deaths from vaccine-preventable diseases. Others argue that, for compulsory vaccination to effectively Vaccine hesitancy is a delay in acceptance, or refusal of vaccines despite availability and supporting evidence. of compulsory vaccination cite the well-documented public health benefits of vaccination. Although adverse effects associated with vaccines are occasionally observed, the scientific consensus that vaccines are generally safe and effective is overwhelming 25670c2f35

Smallpox vaccine The term vaccine derives from vacca, the Latin word for cow, reflecting the origins of smallpox vaccination. From 1958 to 1977, the World Health Organization (WHO) conducted a global vaccination campaign that eradicated smallpox, making it the only human disease to be eradicated. Cowpox served as a natural vaccine until the modern smallpox vaccine emerged in the 20th century. In 1796, British physician Edward Jenner demonstrated that an infection with the relatively mild cowpox virus conferred immunity against the deadly smallpox virus. Edward Jenner referred to cowpox as variolae The smallpox vaccine is used to prevent smallpox infection caused by the variola virus. Although routine smallpox vaccination is no longer performed on the general public, the vaccine is still being produced for research, and to guard against bioterrorism, biological warfare, and mpox. It is the first vaccine to have been developed against a contagious disease 25670c2f35
