Allin Cornell A seismic hazard is the probability that an earthquake will occur in a given geographic area, within a given window of time, and with ground motion intensity exceeding a given threshold. It is important to clarify which MCE is being discussed. The seismic hazard studies also may generate two standard measures of anticipated ground motion, both confusingly abbreviated MCE; the simpler probabilistic Maximum Considered Earthquake (or Event), used in standard building codes, and the more detailed and deterministic Maximum Credible Earthquake incorporated in the design of larger buildings and civil infrastructure like dams or 11ad6528e7

Well logging Some types of geophysical well logs can be done during any phase of a well's history: drilling, completing, producing, or abandoning. The log may be based either on visual inspection of samples brought to the surface (geological logs) or on physical measurements made by instruments lowered into the hole (geophysical logs). logging operations can either be performed during the drilling process (see Logging While Drilling), to provide real-time information about the formations Well logging, also known as borehole logging is the practice of making a detailed record (a well log) of the geologic formations penetrated by a borehole. Well logging is performed in boreholes drilled for the oil and gas, groundwater, mineral and geothermal exploration, as well as part of environmental, scientific and geotechnical studies

Well kill Well kills may be planned in the case of advanced interventions such as workovers, or be contingency

operations. During drilling, pressure control is maintained through the use of precisely concocted drilling fluid, which balances out the pressure. A well kill is the operation of placing a column of special fluids of the required density into a well bore in order to prevent the flow of reservoir fluids without the need for pressure control equipment at the surface. It works on the principle that the hydrostatic head of the "kill fluid" or "kill mud" will be enough to suppress the pressure of the formation fluids. The situation calling for a well kill will dictate the method taken. with successive steps 11ad6528e7

In aircraft and racing applications, stainless steel wire is used, such as in 0.8 mm (0.032 in) diameter.
