polymorphism is the ability of lipids to aggregate in a variety of ways, giving rise to structures of different shapes, known as "phases". More complicated aggregations have also been observed, such as rhombohedral, tetragonal and orthorhombic phases 36eea6ee24

Peripheral membrane protein Peripheral membrane proteins, or extrinsic membrane proteins, are membrane proteins that adhere only temporarily to the biological membrane with which Peripheral membrane proteins, or extrinsic membrane proteins, are membrane proteins that adhere only temporarily to the biological membrane with which they are associated. These proteins attach to integral membrane proteins, or penetrate the peripheral regions of the lipid bilayer. In contrast to integral membrane proteins, peripheral membrane proteins tend to collect in the water-soluble component, or fraction, of all the proteins extracted during a protein purification procedure. Proteins with GPI anchors are an exception to this rule and can have purification properties similar to those of integral membrane proteins. The regulatory protein subunits of many ion channels and transmembrane receptors, for example, may be defined as peripheral
