Underwater construction Remotely operated underwater vehicles are an alternative for some classes of work, but are also limited and expensive. It is a part of the marine construction industry. It can involve the use of a variety of building materials, mainly

concrete and steel. And it is hazardous work, with expensive risk reduction and mitigation, and a limited range of suitable equipment. There is often, but not necessarily, a significant component of commercial diving involved. Some underwater work can be done by divers, but they are limited by depth and site conditions. One strategy is to fully construct the offshore facility onshore, and tow the installation to site floating on its own buoyancy. Bottom founded structures are lowered to the seabed by de-ballasting (see for instance Condeep or Crane-free), whilst floating structures are held in position with substantial mooring systems. Robotic or motorized total stations allow the operator to control the instrument from a distance via remote control. In theory, this eliminates the need for an assistant staff member, as the operator holds the retroreflector and controls the total station from the observed point. In practice, however, an assistant surveyor is often needed when the surveying is being conducted in busy areas...
