User-centered design In User-centered design (UCD) or user-driven development (UDD) is a framework of processes in which usability goals, user characteristics, environment, tasks and workflow of a product, service or brand are given extensive attention at each stage of the design process. This attention includes testing which is conducted during each stage of design and development from the envisioned requirements, through pre-production models to post production. usability testing and other methods. Design science (methodology) Design science research methodology (DSRM) refers to the research methodologies associated with this paradigm. Herbert Simon

distinguished the natural sciences, concerned with explaining how things are, from design sciences which are concerned with how things ought to be, that is, with devising artifacts to attain goals. Design science research (DSR) is a research paradigm focusing on the development and validation of prescriptive knowledge in information science. It spans the methodologies of several research disciplines, for example information technology, which offers specific guidelines for evaluation and iteration within research projects.
