The show was originally pitched to several US and UK channels, and eventually landed with Showtime, with Sky Atlantic as co-producer. The series premiered on Showtime in the United States on May 11, 2014, and on Sky Atlantic in the United Kingdom on May 20, 2014. It premiered at the South by Southwest film festival on March 9 and began airing on television on April 28, 2014, on Showtime on Demand.
