Celadon 61) Maebyeong Celadon () is a term for pottery denoting both wares glazed in the jade green celadon color, also known as greenware or "green ware" (the term specialists now tend to use), and a type of transparent glaze, often with small cracks, that was first used on greenware, but later used on other porcelains. Eventually, European potteries produced some pieces, but it was never a major element there. Celadon Museum are two regional museums that focus on Korean greenware.
