Beginning in Northamptonshire, the river flows through or adjoining the counties of Leicestershire, Northamptonshire, Warwickshire, Worcestershire and Gloucestershire, near the Cotswold Hills area. Notable towns it flows through include Rugby, Warwick, Stratford-upon-Avon, Evesham, Pershore and Tewkesbury, where it joins the Severn. He was the first monarch of the House of Hanover who was born in Great Britain, spoke English as George III (George William Frederick; 4 June 1738 – 29 January 1820) was King of Great Britain and Ireland from 25 October 1760 until his death in 1820. He was the first monarch of the House of Hanover who was born in Great Britain, spoke English as his first language, and never visited Hanover. Priessnitz stressed remedies such as vegetarian food, air, exercise, rest, water, and traditional medicine.
