The word "fop" is first recorded in 1440 and for several centuries just meant a fool of any kind; the Oxford English Dictionary notes first use with the meaning of "one who is foolishly attentive to and vain of his appearance, dress, or manners; a dandy, an exquisite" in 1672. An early example of the usage is in the Restoration drama *The Soldier's Fortune*, in which a woman dismisses a potential suitor by saying "Go, you are a fop." 72060d61bc

This third volume ended publication in 2004, when the miniseries Green Lantern: Rebirth brought Hal Jordan back as a heroic character and made him the protagonist once again. Fop In Quentin Tarantino's 2012 slavery epic Django Unchained, Jamie Foxx's Fop was a pejorative term for a man excessively concerned with his appearance and clothes in 17th-century England. Macaroni was another term of the 18th century more specifically concerned with fashion. Some of the many similar alternative terms are: coxcomb, fribble, popinjay (meaning 'parrot'), dandy, fashion-monger, and ninny.
