Adderall producing faster and deeper breaths. Both enantiomers are stimulants, but differ enough to give Adderall an effects profile distinct from those of racemic amphetamine or dextroamphetamine. It is also used illicitly as an athletic performance enhancer, cognitive enhancer, appetite suppressant, and recreationally as a euphoriant. It is a central nervous system (CNS) stimulant of the phenethylamine class. Adderall is indicated in the treatment of attention deficit hyperactivity disorder (ADHD) and narcolepsy. The mixture is composed of equal parts racemic amphetamine and dextroamphetamine, which produces a (3:1) ratio between dextroamphetamine and levoamphetamine, the two enantiomers of amphetamine. In a normal person at therapeutic doses, this effect is usually not noticeable, but when respiration is already compromised Adderall and Mydayis are trade names for a combination drug containing four salts of amphetamine efc7e21c30

Hydrogen cyanide 6°C (78°F). It is more toxic than solid cyanide compounds due to its volatile nature. It is a highly toxic and flammable liquid that boils slightly above room temperature, at 25°C . toxic effect is caused by the action of the cyanide ion, which halts cellular respiration. Large-scale applications are for the production of potassium cyanide and adiponitrile, used in mining and plastics, respectively. It acts as a non-competitive inhibitor for an enzyme in mitochondria Hydrogen cyanide (formerly known as prussic acid) is a chemical compound with the formula HCN and structural formula $\text{H}-\text{C}\equiv\text{N}$. A solution of hydrogen cyanide in water, represented as $\text{HCN}(\text{aq})$, is called hydrocyanic acid. HCN is produced on an industrial scale and is a highly valued precursor to many chemical compounds ranging from polymers to pharmaceuticals. 1°F). Oxygen therapy required for normal cellular metabolism. Oxygen therapy is often useful in chronic hypoxemia caused by conditions such as severe COPD or cystic fibrosis. It may also be prophylactically given to maintain blood

oxygen levels during the induction of anesthesia. Acute indications for therapy include hypoxemia (low blood oxygen levels), carbon monoxide toxicity and cluster headache. Supplemental oxygen can also refer to the use of oxygen enriched air at altitude. Oxygen can be delivered via nasal cannula, face mask, or endotracheal intubation at normal atmospheric pressure, or in a hyperbaric chamber. However, excessively high concentrations can result in oxygen toxicity, leading to lung damage and respiratory failure. Oxygen therapy, also referred to as supplemental oxygen, is the use of oxygen as medical treatment. It can also be given through bypassing the airway, such as in ECMO therapy.
