Two major models have been proposed to explain how this process of integration takes place. According to this model, some traits are more schematic and serve as central traits to shape the overall impression. Social psychologist Solomon Asch is credited with the seminal research on impression formation and conducted research on how individuals integrate information about personality traits. The configural model suggests that people form cohesive impressions by integrating traits into a unified whole, adjusting individual traits to fit an overall context rather than evaluating each trait independently

Procedure word The modern NATO spelling alphabet uses the word ‘Romeo’ for ‘R’; Procedure words (abbreviated to *prowords*) are words or phrases limited to radiotelephony procedure used to facilitate communication by conveying information in a condensed standard verbal format. during World War II, with the ‘R’ changed to the spelling alphabet equivalent word ‘Roger’. Prowords are voice versions of the much older procedural signs for Morse code which were first developed in the 1860s for Morse telegraphy, and their meaning is identical

Henry Sweet described sentence words as 'an area under one's control' and gave words such as "Come!", "John!", "Alas!", "Yes." and "No." as examples of sentence words. The Dutch linguist J. M. Hoogvliet described sentence words as "volzinwoorden". They were also noted in 1891 by Georg von der Gabelentz, whose observations were extensively elaborated by Hoogvliet in 1903; he does not list "Yes." and "No." as sentence words.
