In situ The earliest known use of in situ in the English language dates back to the mid-17th century. pre-planning and incurs higher manufacturing and transportation costs. The term is used across many disciplines to denote methods, observations, or interventions carried out in their natural or intended environment. By contrast, ex situ methods involve the removal or displacement of materials, specimens, or processes for study, preservation, or modification in a controlled setting, often at the cost of contextual integrity. The term typically refers to the examination or occurrence of a process within its original context, without relocation. In geotechnical engineering, the term in situ describes soil in its natural, undisturbed state In situ is a Latin phrase meaning 'in place' or 'on site', derived from in ('in') and situ (ablative of situs, lit. 'place'). In scientific literature, its usage increased from the late 19th century onward, initially in medicine 0d8ac7b8a8
