State Reform School for Boys State Reform School is structured around labor, instruction, and discipline, with a clear schedule for the boys. Recognized as the oldest publicly funded reform school in the United States, its creation represented a significant social experiment in 19th-century America, embarking on an ambitious endeavor to test whether a structured, state-sponsored environment could effectively redirect "delinquent" youth, impart moral discipline, and prepare them for productive lives within society. Reform School for Boys in Westborough, Massachusetts, was a pioneering state institution dedicated to the reformation of juvenile offenders, operating from its establishment in 1848 until its relocation in 1884 db9ec3cb38
