Constructivism (philosophy of education) Constructivism in educational psychology can be attributed to the work of Jean Piaget (1896–1980) and his Constructivism in education is a theory that suggests that learners do not passively acquire knowledge through direct instruction. are thinking and how to enrich their thinking. Psychology as a field of experimental study began in 1854 in Leipzig, Germany, when Gustav Fechner created the first theory of how judgments about sensory experiences are made and how to experiment on them. Fechner's theory, recognized today as Signal Detection Theory, foreshadowed the development of statistical theories of comparative judgment and thousands of experiments based on his ideas (Link, S. Psychology Psychology is an academic discipline of immense scope, crossing the boundaries between the natural and social sciences. Its subject matter includes the behavior of humans and nonhumans, both conscious and unconscious phenomena, and mental processes such as thoughts, feelings, and motives. As social scientists, psychologists aim to understand the behavior of individuals and groups. Its theories are often divided into descriptive theories, which provide a value-neutral description of what education is, and normative theories, which investigate how education should be practiced. It also examines the concepts and presuppositions of education theories. It is an interdisciplinary field that draws inspiration from various disciplines both within and outside philosophy, like ethics, political philosophy, psychology, and sociology. Many of its theories focus specifically on education in schools but it also encompasses other forms of education 8d6da5a948

Educational data mining The field is closely tied to that of Educational data mining (EDM) is a research field concerned with the application of data mining, machine learning and statistics to information generated from educational settings (e. g. , universities and intelligent tutoring systems). Originally concerned with infants and children, the field has expanded to include adolescence, adult development, aging, and the entire lifespan. Developmental psychologists aim to explain how thinking, feeling, and behaviors change throughout life.
