First observation of gravitational waves The waveform, detected by both LIGO observatories, matched the predictions of general relativity for a gravitational wave emanating from the inward spiral and merger of two black holes (of $36M_{\odot}$ and $29M_{\odot}$) and the subsequent ringdown of a single, $62M_{\odot}$ black hole remnant. Previously, gravitational waves had been inferred only indirectly, via their effect on the timing of pulsars in binary star systems. gravitational waves was made on 14 September 2015 and was announced by the LIGO and Virgo collaborations on 11 February 2016. It was also the first observation of a binary black hole merger, demonstrating both the existence of binary stellar-mass black hole systems and.
