A series of incrementally improved models followed, sharing the same integrated case design. In 1987, the Macintosh II brought color graphics, but was priced as a professional workstation and not a personal computer. In response, the illumos project forked OpenSolaris, including ZFS, to continue its development as an open source project. Large parts of Solaris, including ZFS, were published under an open source license as OpenSolaris in 2005. During 2005 to 2010, the open source version of ZFS was ported to Linux, macOS, and FreeBSD. It began as part of the Sun Microsystems Solaris operating system in 2001. Although it was originally marketed as simply "version 10" of Mac OS (indicated by the Roman numeral "X"), it has a completely different codebase from Mac OS 9, as well as substantial changes to its user interface (UI). The transition was a technologically and strategically significant one.
