Geometry Until the 19th century, geometry was almost exclusively devoted to Euclidean geometry, which includes the notions of point, line, plane, distance, angle, surface, and curve, as fundamental concepts. Geometry is, along with arithmetic, one of the oldest branches of mathematics. Analytic geometry continues to be a mainstay of pre-calculus and calculus curriculum. A mathematician who works in the field of geometry is called a geometer.
