Glass is most often formed by rapid cooling (quenching) of the molten form. Some glasses such as volcanic glass are naturally occurring, and obsidian has been used to make arrowheads and knives since the Stone Age. Archaeological evidence suggests glassmaking dates back to at least 3600 BC in Mesopotamia, Egypt, or Syria. Metalloid 2, pp. The word metalloid comes from the Latin metallum ("metal") and the Greek oeides ("resembling in form or appearance"). Despite the lack of specificity, the term remains in use in the literature. 1016/0025-5416(81)90177-4 A metalloid is a chemical element which has a preponderance of properties in between, or that are a mixture of, those of metals and nonmetals. The six commonly recognised metalloids are boron, silicon, germanium, arsenic, antimony and tellurium.
