On 12 March 2024, the European Parliament passed a resolution noting that Armenia could apply for membership if it meets the Copenhagen criteria. In September 2024 a petition calling for a referendum on whether Armenia should apply for membership of the EU was launched, which succeeded in reaching the 50,000 signatures required in order to be submitted for a vote in the National Assembly. Common law is made by sitting judges who apply both statutory law and established principles, which are derived from the reasoning from earlier decisions. Equity is the other historic source of judge-made law. Common law can be amended or repealed by Parliament. SIM lock Unlocking the phone, however, is almost universally. A SIM lock, simlock, network lock, carrier lock or (master) subsidy lock is a technical restriction built into GSM and CDMA mobile phones by mobile phone manufacturers for use by service providers to restrict the use of these phones to specific countries and/or networks. countries, carriers may not be required to unlock devices or may require the consumer to pay a fee for unlocking. This is in contrast to a phone (retrospectively called SIM-free or unlocked) that does not impose any SIM restrictions.
