Convex hull They can be In geometry, the convex hull, convex envelope or convex closure of a shape is the smallest convex set that contains it. For a bounded subset of the plane, the convex hull may be visualized as the shape enclosed by a rubber band stretched around the subset. Ozone Ozone is formed from dioxygen by the action of ultraviolet (UV) light and electrical discharges within the Earth's atmosphere. It is a pale-blue gas with a distinctively pungent odor. It is an allotrope of oxygen that is much less stable than the diatomic allotrope O_2 , breaking down in the lower atmosphere to O_2 (dioxygen). lead to molecular oxygen, and this means that the reaction order and the rate law cannot be determined by the stoichiometry of the overall reaction. Overall Ozone (), also called trioxygen, is an inorganic molecule with the chemical formula O_3 . It is present in very low concentrations throughout the atmosphere, with its highest concentration high in the ozone layer of the stratosphere, which absorbs most of the Sun's ultraviolet (UV) radiation 86c8dd8aa3

The element normally exhibits six allotropes and four oxidation states. It reacts with carbon, halogens, nitrogen, silicon, and hydrogen. It is a silvery-gray actinide metal that tarnishes when exposed to air, and forms a dull coating when oxidized
