If p really is prime, it will always answer yes, but if p is not a prime number (or a prime) is a natural number greater than 1 that is not a product of two smaller

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natural numbers. Primes are central in number theory because of the fundamental theorem of arithmetic: every natural number greater than 1 is either a prime itself or can be factorized as a product of primes that is unique up to their order. Gottlob Frege Frege is widely considered to be the greatest logician since Aristotle, and one of the most profound philosophers of mathematics ever. His book the Foundations of Arithmetic is the seminal text of the logicist project, and is cited Friedrich Ludwig Gottlob Frege (; German: [ˈɡɔtloːp ˈfreːgə]; 8 November 1848 – 26 July 1925) was a German philosopher, logician, and mathematician. Though he was largely ignored during his lifetime, Giuseppe Peano (1858–1932), Bertrand Russell (1872–1970), and, to some extent, Ludwig Wittgenstein (1889–1951) introduced his work to later generations of philosophers. He was a mathematics professor at the University of Jena, and is understood by many to be the father of analytic philosophy, concentrating on the
