It results from the build-up of plaques formed of cholesterol, in the large arteries of the brain, and can be mild to significant. 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Glucocorticoid (including both B cells and T cells), monocytes, macrophages, and the anatomical barrier function of the skin. The name "glucocorticoid" is a portmanteau of "glucose", "cortex", and "steroid", referring to its role in regulating the metabolism of glucose, its synthesis in the adrenal cortex, and its steroidal structure. Glucocorticoids are corticosteroids that bind to the glucocorticoid receptor that is present in almost every vertebrate animal cell. In chronic venous insufficiency, sonographic examination is of most benefit; in confirming varicose disease, making an assessment of the hemodynamics, and charting the progression of the disease and its response to treatment. As with heart ultrasound (echocardiography) studies, venous ultrasonography requires an understanding of hemodynamics in order to give useful examination reports. It gives information about the anatomy, physiology and pathology of mainly superficial veins. Perforator veins drain superficial veins into the deep veins
