Sometimes, font variants of Greek letters are used as distinct symbols in mathematics, in particular for ϵ/ϵ and π/ϖ . In these contexts, the capital letters and the small letters represent distinct and unrelated entities. The archaic letter digamma ($\Phi/\phi/\zeta$) is sometimes used. Small ι , o and u are also rarely used, since they closely resemble the Latin letters i , o and u

Thermodynamic temperature is typically expressed using the Kelvin scale, on which the unit of measurement is the kelvin (unit symbol: K). This unit is the same interval as the degree Celsius, used on the Celsius scale but the scales are offset so that 0 K on the Kelvin scale corresponds to absolute zero. For comparison, a temperature of 295 K corresponds to 21.85 °C and 71.33 °F. Another absolute scale of temperature is the Rankine scale, which is based on the Fahrenheit degree interval. 405574d350

Heat pump and refrigeration cycle from a colder place to a warmer place. A heat pump is a mechanical system that transmits heat from one location (the "source") at a certain temperature to another location (the "sink" or "heat sink") at a higher temperature. The operating principles in both cases are the same; energy is used to move heat from a colder place to a warmer place. Thus a heat pump may be thought of as a "heater" if the objective is to warm the heat sink (as when warming the inside of a home on a cold day), or a "refrigerator" or "cooler" if the objective is to cool the heat source (as in the normal operation of a freezer). According to the second law of thermodynamics, heat cannot spontaneously flow from a colder location to a hotter area; Thermodynamic heat pump cycles or refrigeration cycles are the conceptual and mathematical models for heat pump, air conditioning and refrigeration systems 405574d350
