The term is generally employed in sociology and the other social sciences, as well as in philosophy and bioethics. It refers to the ties in a society that bind people together as one. True solidarity means moving beyond individual identities and single issue politics. It is a significant concept in Catholic social teaching and in Christian democratic political ideology.
