This has led to cybersecurity Audio deepfake technology, also referred to as voice cloning or deepfake audio, is an application of artificial intelligence designed to generate speech that convincingly mimics specific individuals, often synthesizing phrases or sentences they have never spoken. using simple mobile devices or personal computers. Additionally, it has commercial uses, including the creation of personalized digital assistants,

natural-sounding text-to-speech systems, and advanced speech translation services. These tools have also been used to spread misinformation using audio

Headphones Another type, known as earbuds or earpieces, consists of individual units that plug into the user's ear canal; within that category have been developed cordless air buds using wireless technology. Headphones let a single user listen to an audio source privately, in contrast to a loudspeaker, which emits sound into the open air for anyone nearby to hear. However, one hearing expert found in 2012 (before the worldwide adoption of smartphones as the main personal listening device) that headphones are a pair of small loudspeaker drivers worn on or around the head over a user's ears. Headphones are also known as earphones or, colloquially, cans. personal audio devices and smartphones. Circumaural (around the ear) and supra-aural (over the ear) headphones use a band over the top of the head to hold the drivers in place. They are electroacoustic transducers, which convert an electrical signal to a corresponding sound. A third type are bone conduction headphones, which

Sound from ultrasound peripheral sound and related noise of a loudspeaker. It can be used for personal audio, either to have sounds audible to only one person, or that which a group can hear. Sound from ultrasound is the name given here to the generation of audible sound from modulated ultrasound without using an active receiver. This happens when the modulated ultrasound passes through a nonlinear medium which acts, intentionally or unintentionally, as a demodulator
