Ferrous metallurgy During the Industrial Revolution, new methods of producing bar iron emerged Ferrous metallurgy is the metallurgy of iron and its alloys. All these processes required charcoal as fuel. The earliest surviving prehistoric iron artifacts, from the 4th millennium BC in Egypt, were made from meteoritic iron-nickel. carburizing bars of iron in the cementation process were devised in the 17th century. During the medieval period, smiths in Europe found a way of producing wrought iron from cast iron, in this context known as pig iron, using finery forges. It is not known when or where the smelting of iron from ores began, but by the end of the 2nd millennium BC iron was being produced from iron ores in the region from Greece to India, The use of wrought iron (worked iron) was known by the 1st millennium BC, and its spread defined the Iron Age b8b580a7ec
