There are many different varieties of puppets, and they are made of a wide range of materials, depending on their form and intended use. They can be extremely complex or very simple in their construction. The simplest puppets are finger puppets, which are tiny puppets that fit onto a single finger, and sock puppets, which are formed from a sock and operated by inserting one's hand inside the sock, with the opening and closing of the hand simulating the movement of the puppet's "mouth". A hand puppet or glove puppet is controlled by one hand which...

Papier-mâché Papier-mâché (UK: /ˌpæpiər ˈmæʃeɪ/ PAP-ee-ay MASH-ay, US: /ˌpeɪpər məˈʃeɪ/ PAY-pər mə-SHAY, French: papier mâché [papje mɑʃe] – the French term "mâché"; Papier-mâché (UK: PAP-ee-ay MASH-ay, US: PAY-pər mə-SHAY, French: papier mâché [papje mɑʃe] – the French term "mâché" here means "crushed and ground") is a versatile craft technique with roots in ancient China, in which waste paper is shredded and mixed with water and a binder to produce a pulp ideal for modelling or moulding, which dries to a hard surface and allows the creation of light, strong and inexpensive objects of any shape, even very complicated ones. Millboard is a type of strong pasteboard that contains old rope and other coarse materials in addition. Binding agents include glue, starch or wallpaper paste. Papier-mâché reinforced with textiles or boiled cardboard (carton bouilli) can be used for durable, sturdy objects. Pasteboard is made of whole sheets of paper glued together, or layers of paper pulp pressed together. There is even carton-cuir (cardboard and leather) and also a "laminating process", a method in which strips of paper are glued together in layers. "Carton-paille" or strawboard was already described in a book in 1881. There are various recipes, including those using cardboard and some mineral elements such as chalk or clay (carton-pierre, a building material)

Puppetry The puppeteer sometimes speaks in the voice of the character of the puppet, while at other times they perform to a recorded soundtrack. Such a performance is also known as a puppet production. Glove puppets are also known as sleeve, hand or palm puppets. Puppeteers use movements from hands and arms to control devices such as rods or strings to move the body, head, limbs, and in some cases the mouth and eyes of the puppet. The head is made of either papier-mâché, cloth Puppetry is a form of theatre or performance that involves the manipulation of puppets, the inanimate objects, often resembling some type of human or animal figure, that are animated or manipulated by a human called a puppeteer. traditional rod puppet of Bihar is known as Yampuri.
