Pulmonary function testing The primary Pulmonary function testing (PFT) is a complete evaluation of the respiratory system including patient history, physical examinations, and tests of pulmonary function. The primary purpose of pulmonary function testing is to identify the severity of pulmonary impairment. Pulmonary function testing has diagnostic and therapeutic roles and helps clinicians answer some general questions about patients with lung disease. PFTs are normally performed by a pulmonary function technologist, respiratory therapist, respiratory physiologist, physiotherapist, pulmonologist, or general practitioner. Hypercapnia Inability of the lungs to clear carbon dioxide, or inhalation of elevated levels of CO₂, leads to respiratory acidosis. Carbon dioxide is a gaseous product of the body's metabolism and is normally expelled through the lungs. Eventually the body compensates for the raised acidity by retaining alkali in the kidneys, a process known as "metabolic compensation. compensation". Carbon dioxide may accumulate in any condition that causes hypoventilation, a reduction of alveolar ventilation (the clearance of air from the small sacs of the lung where gas exchange takes place) as well as resulting from inhalation of CO₂. Acute hypercapnia is called acute hypercapnic respiratory failure (AHRF) and is a medical emergency as it generally occurs in the context Hypercapnia (from the Greek hyper, "above" or "too much" and kapnos, "smoke"), also known as hypercarbia and CO₂ retention, is a condition of abnormally elevated carbon dioxide (CO₂) levels in the blood 76f8658e70

Shortness of breath The American Thoracic Society defines it as "a subjective experience of breathing discomfort that consists of qualitatively distinct sensations that vary in intensity", and

recommends evaluating dyspnea by assessing the intensity of its distinct sensations, the degree of distress and discomfort involved, and its burden or impact on the patient's activities of daily living. Distinct sensations include effort/work to breathe, chest tightness or pain, and "air hunger" (the feeling of not enough oxygen). PMID 26028608. Nedocromil sodium has been shown to be effective in alleviating symptoms of allergic conjunctivitis. It is administered by an inhaler under the brand name Tilade, and as an eye drop under the brand name Alocril. The effects of nedocromil versus asthma are gradual rather than fast-acting and it is not indicated for acute respiratory distress compared to fast acting bronchodilators like albuterol or other well-known inhaler medications

Oxygen therapy Higher oxygen concentrations can also increase the risk of Oxygen therapy, also referred to as supplemental oxygen, is the use of oxygen as medical treatment. It may also be prophylactically given to maintain blood oxygen levels during the induction of anesthesia. It can also be given through bypassing the airway, such as in ECMO therapy. Oxygen therapy is often useful in chronic hypoxemia caused by conditions such as severe COPD or cystic fibrosis. concentrations can result in oxygen toxicity, leading to lung damage and respiratory failure. Oxygen can be delivered via nasal cannula, face mask, or endotracheal intubation at normal atmospheric pressure, or in a hyperbaric chamber. Supplemental oxygen can also refer to the use of oxygen enriched air at altitude. Acute indications for therapy include hypoxemia (low blood oxygen levels), carbon monoxide toxicity and cluster headache

When difference equations are employed, the theory is called discrete dynamical systems.
